Meeting Summary

Meeting was called to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The Secretary/Treasurer gave the financial report. The ending balance for 2011 was \$1518.13. We have had 2 deposits totaling \$180.00. A check was written to Joe Mirabella for a total of \$471.00 of which \$417.96 was for the computer and \$33.75 for the tabs for the trailer. The ending balance is now \$1246.42.

Meeting turned over to Dwayne Roberts. Dwayne asked all the Board Members if they wanted to remain in their positions. Each answered "yes". Dwayne Roberts is in his 2nd year of his 3 year term, Debbie Gores is in her 2nd year of her 2 year term, Joe Mirabella, JR Stark and Nate Thompson are re-elected as 1 year board members. Margie Mirabella is re-elected as Secretary/Treasurer for another year. Jim Rogers re-elected President. Dwayne asked if anyone was interested in the position of Vice President. Vice President is Tom Dillon replacing Bruce Thompson. Jim Rogers asked for a vote on the members and it was seconded by Pete Hawkins. Approved by a show of hands.

Jim received a letter from Joe D'Amico regarding the Fort Discovery "Unity of Effort" celebration. He asked us to represent our club by dressing up and bringing guns etc. It is scheduled for August 11, 2012. Pete Hawkins attended last year and said it was fun. Jim and Dwayne would like full club participation at the Fort Discovery "Unity of Effort" celebration. Don Gores wants to have a .22 silhouette shoot. Don has purchased 40 steel silhouette targets. Dwayne asked if Don would bring the targets to the next shoot. Jim asked if anyone was interested in shooting trap or 5 stand with their cowboy shotguns at the Port Angeles Gun Club. Jim wants everyone to think about it.

Jeff Doane brought up the issue of match director and Dwayne said they were going to run it by committee. Jeff mentioned that the by-laws state that the club has a match director. If the club wants it to be by committee, the by-laws must be changed.

Debbie Gores thanked Jeff Doane for the job he did as Match Director.
